

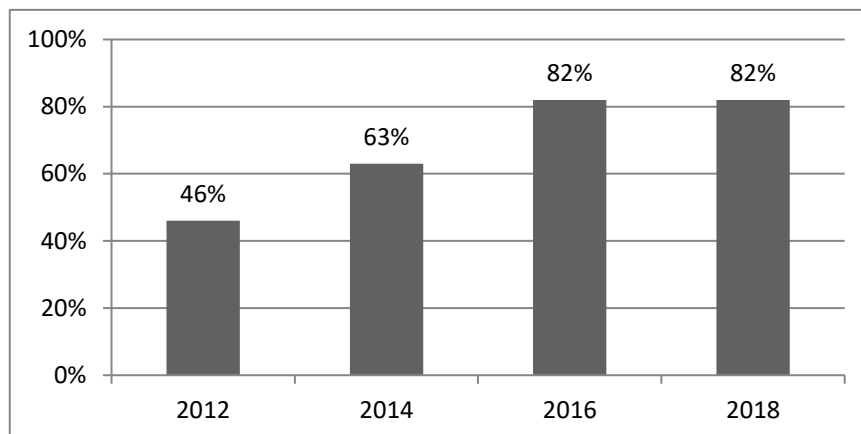

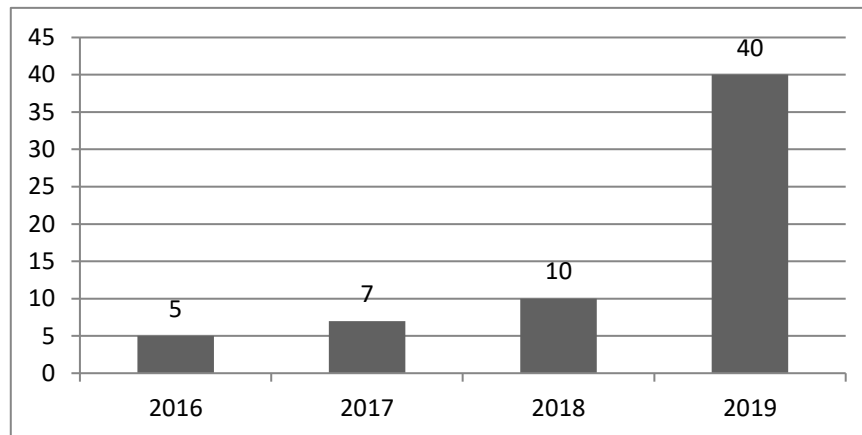
*Topic:* **Street music**
