

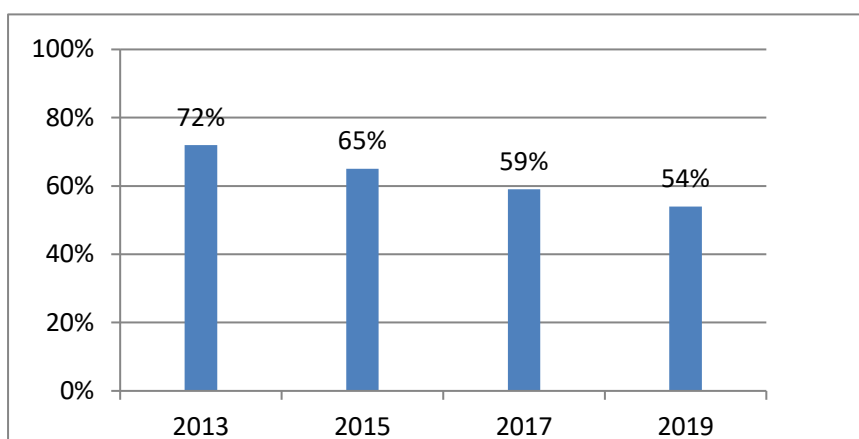

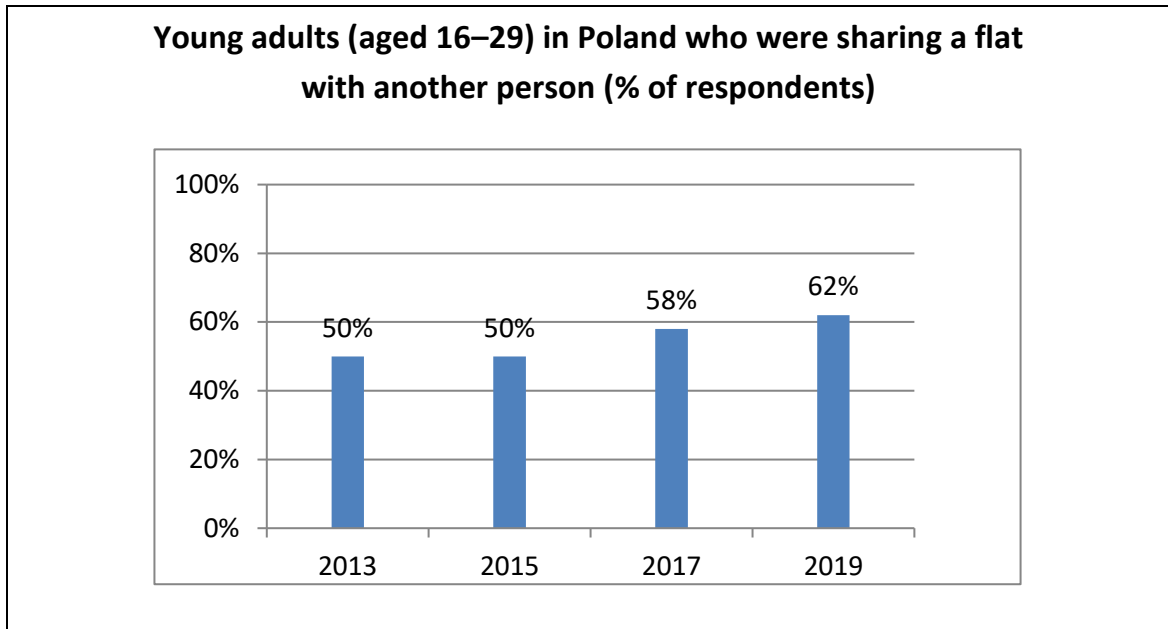
Topic: **Theatre and drama activities**
