

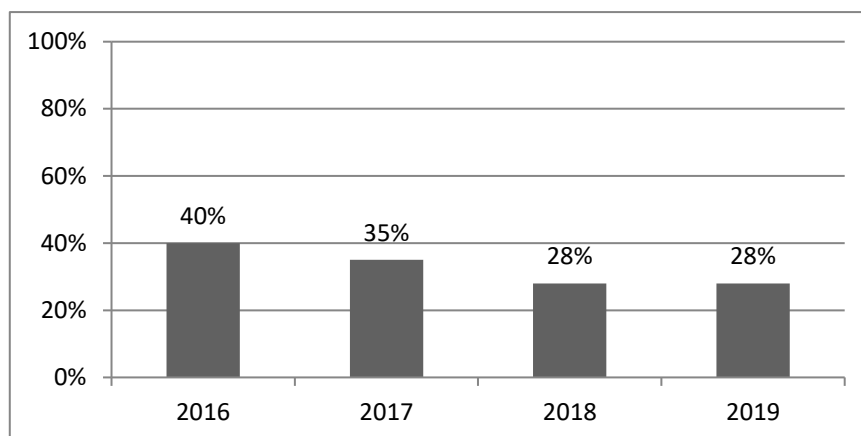

*Time:* 3–4 minutes

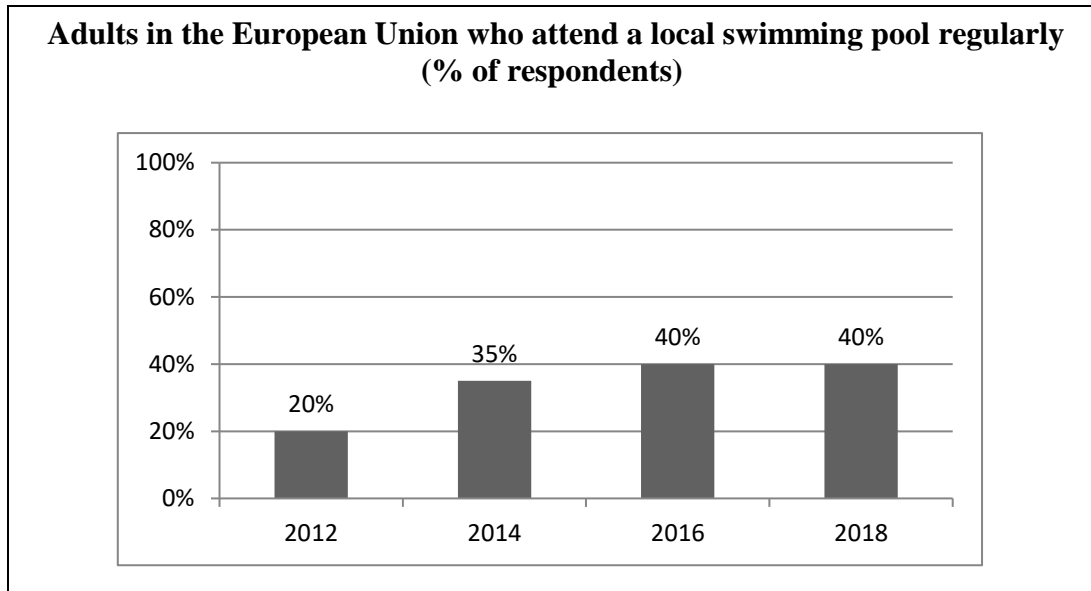
*Topic:* **Photography club**
