 - Why does cancel culture create fear around making mistakes, and how does this impact communication or learning?
 - How can societies protect freedom of expression while ensuring that individuals take responsibility for their words? Why is this balance important?
- ❖ *Additional question: Do you think mistakes made by public figures should be treated differently from those made by ordinary people? Why or why not?*
