Topic: **Time & Distraction**

Task: Read the statement and answer the questions below.

Complaints about a lack of time are common, yet the way attention is used throughout the day is rarely questioned.

- What is your reaction to the content of the statement? Justify your answer by explaining why.
 - Why do distractions make it difficult for people to use their time effectively, and how serious do you think this problem is?
 - Why do people often feel they have plenty of time when they are young, and how might this perception influence the way they think about time?
- ❖ *Additional question: Do people of different ages face different kinds of distractions? Why or why not?*
