Task: Read the statement and answer the questions below.

Topic: **Risk & Security**

Task: Read the statement and answer the questions below.

The belief that “it won’t happen to me” leads individuals to underestimate risks and engage in dangerous behavior despite being aware of potential consequences.

- What is your reaction to the content of the statement? Justify your answer by explaining why.
 - Why do people often avoid risks even when they understand the possible benefits, and how does this affect young people’s choices?
 - How could young people be encouraged to take responsible risks, and why would this be effective?
- ❖ *Additional question: What long-term consequences might arise if young people are discouraged from taking risks during their formative years?*
