Topic: **Adulthood & Social Pressure**

Task: Read the statement and answer the questions below.

Reaching the legal age of adulthood is often linked to freedom, yet real independence does not always follow as expected.

- What is your reaction to the content of the statement? Justify your answer by explaining why.
 - Why do family and society continue to shape decisions in early adulthood, and how would you judge the strength of that influence?
 - How can young people make more independent decisions despite outside pressure, and why would your ideas actually work?
- ❖ *Additional question: Which expectations that other people have about us feel the most difficult to manage?*
